## AMCSI COLLEGE GRANT FUNDING

AMCSI College Grant funds will be dispersed evenly for **two semesters**. Currently grant holders will get **\$500 per semester** as long as the student can prove that he or she has been able to maintain a C average GPA for entering into the first year of college studies. If a student is currently in collegiate academia studies he or she must be maintaining at least a B average GPA in order to be awarded the requested funds.

All AMCSI College Grant funds are awarded to current AMCSI members with the diagnosis of arthrogryposis multiplex congenita.
